The Florida Association of Environmental Professionals (FAEP) and the Tallahassee Chapter are honored to host the 2017 Annual Conference and Training Symposium in Tallahassee, on the 14th and 15th of September 2017. - The preferred method of contact
- Professional title and/or year of doctoral program
- Affiliation
- Biography
- Presentation title and a brief description of your presentation topic
- Estimated presentation length in minutes (if speaking)
- Which of the conference topics your presentation is related to

Title must accurately and concisely reflect the abstract content. **The presentation description must be 200 words or less** and submitted in MS Word in the above format.
